2. Skill based course –Travel and Tourism Management

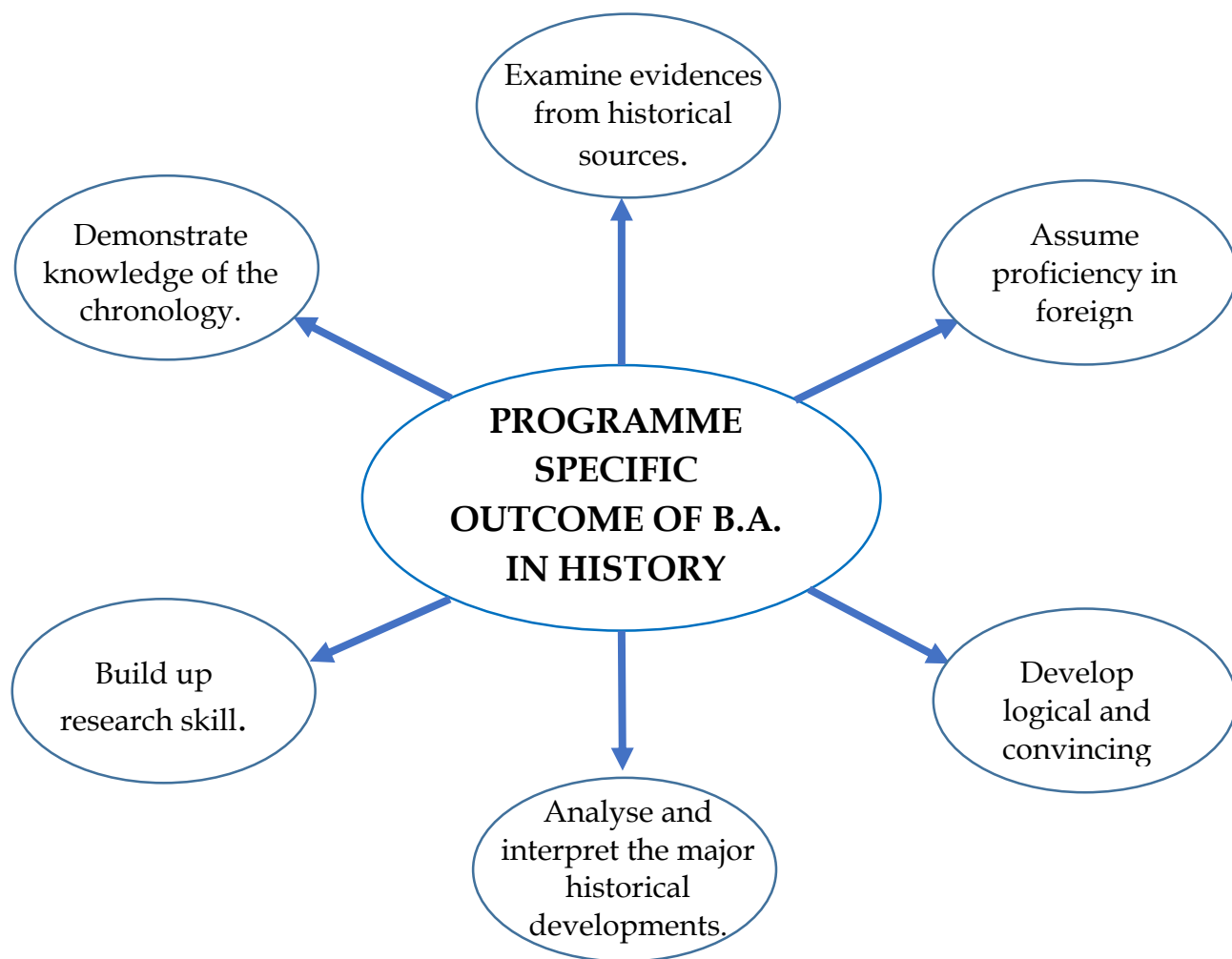

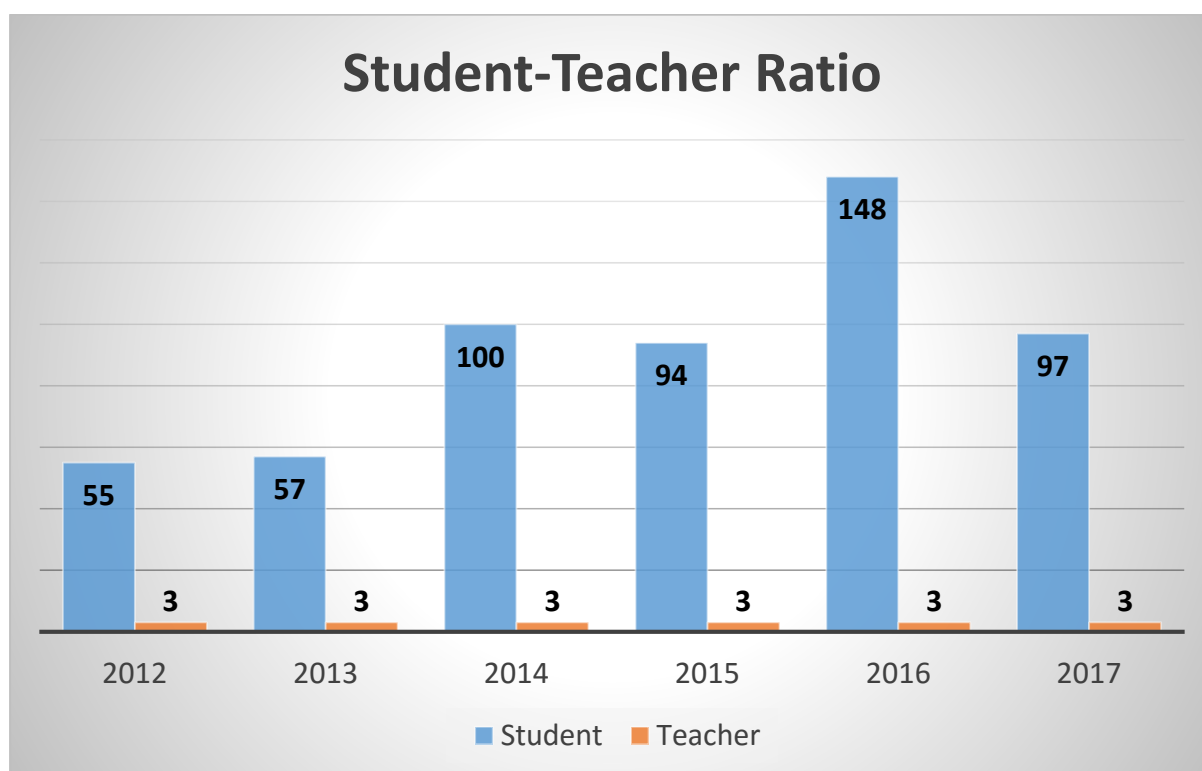

- v. Many students participated in NCC, NSS Programmes and in the various Programmes of the College Week such as in singing, dancing quiz, debate, recitation, sports etc. The teachers are also actively involved in the college week programme.

Healthy and Good Practices of the Department :

The department formed History Study Circle under the guidance of Dr. Dipali Baruah, the former HoD of the Department. This study circle organized Seminars, Group Discussion, Essay Competition, Field Work. A Wall Magazine has prepared by the students and celebrated Fresher's Social, Teachers Day, Students Farewell etc.

The good practices that observed by the History Study Circle as follows :

- i. **Felicitation Programme:** Miss Swapna Baruah, the student of History Department has been awarded with a Gold Medal at the Kick Boxing Event in "World Kick Boxing Events" under "World Martial Art Game" at Hua Mak Stadium, Bangkok on 12-22 March, 2015. The Department of History organized a felicitation programme on 4th April, 2015 to felicitate Miss Swapna Baruah. The basic **objective** of this programme was to inspire her achievement at Bangkok and tried to inspire other students for the growth and development of their talents in different fields.
- ii. **Inter Disciplinary Lectures:** A series of inter disciplinary lectures are organized by the Department of History. The **objective** of this programme is to enhance the knowledge of the students in different discipline. These lectures are as follows.

- d) "Green Revolution" on 22nd March, 2018 by Mr. Utpal Sut, Assistant Professor, Department of Economics, M.D.K.G. College, Dibrugarh.
- iii) **Essay Competition:** An Essay Competition was organized on Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose on 23rd January, 2017 on the occasion of his birthday.
- iv) A speech was organized on "**Assam and the Freedom Movement**" on 14th August, 2017. The speech was delivered by the Students of 5th Semester.
- v) An interaction programme "**Colloquim with Nibedita Gogoi and Jaahnabi Sonowal, Civil Service Officer, Assam**" was organised by the Dept. Of History with collaboration of the Dept. Of Geography, with the past pupil Jahnabi Sonowal and Nibedita Gogoi on 9th June 2018.

The objective of the programme was to inspire the students in appearing the competitive examination.

- vi) A lecture was organised by the History Dept. On 19th June 2018 on "The Peasants Revolt in Assam. The lecture was delivered by Dr. Chandana Goswami, Associate Professor, Dept. of History, D.H.S.K College, Dibrugarh.

The objective of the programme was to extend the knowledge of the students on economic and social condition of the peasants during the colonial period.

Best Practice :

The teacher and the students of the Department of History went on a tour to Sibsagar District on 28th February, 2016. The **objective** of this tour was to see the architecture and sculptural works of the building and temples of Sibsagar Town and Gargaon. The Ahom rulers built many buildings and temples at Sibsagar district and Gargaon. These buildings and temples are valuable as a source of their study of History of medieval Assam. The field work also enhanced the good relationship among the teachers and students.

The 'World Habitat Day' was observed by the department of History in association with NSS unit, M.D.K.G. College, Dibrugarh, on the 1st October, 2018.
