

Agenda 2: Preparation of SSR for 2022-23:



AGENDA 1: PREPARATION OF IIQA AND SSR:



Date: 10th June, 2023


The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of DHSK Commerce College presents the Action Taken Report on the resolutions made during various IQAC meetings. The college has undertaken numerous initiatives and projects to enhance the overall quality and infrastructure. The following actions have been taken as per the resolutions:

1. Construction of top floor of the Extended Blocks (A, B & C) of the College building has been completed, providing additional space for academic and administrative purposes.
2. Improvement of covered parking facility for students and staff in the campus has been done to enhance convenience and safety.
3. Renovation of canteen facilities has been completed, offering a pleasant environment for students and staff during breaks.
4. Construction of a multistoried building is in progress, aiming to create more classrooms and facilities.
5. Construction of Boys' Hostel is in progress, catering to the accommodation needs of outstation male students.
6. Development of the second campus at Banipur is in progress, expanding the college's reach and facilities.
7. Setting up of a computer lab in the College with 50 computers, promoting digital learning and technological advancement.
