



Alumni Feedback Analysis Report 2021-22




















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#### **Report:**

- ➤ About 48.7% of the respondents express the college academic environment as excellent and 47.4% as good.
- ➤ 52.6% rated the infrastructure as good, 29.5% as excellent and 14.1% as average.
- ➤ 44.9% of alumni members rated that the academic skills and knowledge of faculty members is good and 43.6% stated that it is good.
- ➤ 43.6% are of the opinion that the facilities of College library are good and 25.6% felt it was average
- ➤ 44.9% are of the opinion that the quality of support and study materials provided by the teachers is excellent and 43.6% rated it as good.
- Regarding the social environment in terms of diversity and inclusiveness of the College, 48.7% alumni rated it to be good, 38.5% as excellent.
- ➤ 43.6% of the alumni are of the opinion that the festivals, events and extra curricular activities organized by the college are good and 33.3% felt it was excellent.
- ➤ 29.5% of members stated that the placements opportunity provided by the College is poor and 26.9% stated that it is good.
- ➤ In so far professional status is concerned 47. 4% of alumni members stated that they were engaged in other sector rather than public and private sector after leaving the college.

#### **Suggestions:**

The following suggestions can be deduced from the analysis of alumni feedback

- Need to improve in extra curricular activities
- More practical knowledge is needed
- Arrange more placement drives in the College
- Introduce more certificate course
- Focus more on teaching useful skills like SEO marketing, blogging, tally etc.
- Ensure availability of updated self help books
- Library facility need to be more updated
- Provide more financial support for the economically weaker students.






#### STUDENTS FEEDBACK AND ANALYSIS REPORT 2021-22












It was observed that 69.1% students have said that the teachers' preparation for the classes was very satisfactory whereas 22.5% said that teacher communicated thoroughly with the students.




Maximum number of students(32.9%) have said that the teachers approaches were very good at maintaining teaching



It was noticed that Majority (55.4%) of agreed that the periodical assessments are conducted as per schedule. 23.5% of students strongly agreed with this statement.




It was found that, 53.4% of students have said that the internal evaluation process done by the teachers was always fair. .




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







Nearly half of the students (49.8%) have said that the teaching and mentoring processes in the College facilitate very well in cognitive, social and emotional growth.




It was observed that almost 50% of the students agreed with statement that the College provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow whereas 23.1% students strongly agreed it.




A maximum student (38.1%) has said that teachers inform them every time about their expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.




# 13. The College / teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.








It was found that 33.9% of students agreed that College moderately takes initiative to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills for the world of work.






It was found that more than 50% of students have said that the College administrative office is helpful where as 30.9% said it was very helpful.






It was found that 35.8% of the students have said that the computer & internet facilities of the College are good where as 15.3% stated it as poor.







It was noticed that 30.3% of the students have said that the free admission system & scholarship facility of the college is good where as 26.7% students said it was very good.






It was found that 36.5% of students have said that the boys & girls common room facility of the College are good where as 20.5% students said that it was excellent.


- a) To know the opinion of teachers of DHSK Commerce College towards academic environment of the college.
- b) To understand the need and requirements of teachers towards facilities available in the college campus in the process of teaching learning.


























#### **Analysis of the Report:**

- 1. 60.6% of faculties agree that they have clear knowledge about the vision, mission & objectives of the College
- 2. Most of teacher (45.5%) strongly agreed that the aims and objectives of the present undergraduate CBCS syllabi are well defined and clear to teachers and students.
- 3. It is also observed that 45.5% of teachers strongly agreed with the programmes outcomes / course outcome of the syllabi.
- 4. 45.5% of teachers agreed that the curriculum have good academic flexibility to fulfill the needs of the students.
- 5. 51.5% of teachers agreed that sufficient text books, reference books and resources are available in the College library & departmental library.
- 6. Half of the faculty members (51.5%) agreed that the sufficient computer and ICT facilities are available in the College for ICT based teaching to students.
- 7. The teachers' feedback on College administration & management was mostly positive as 63.6% of them strongly agreed it.
- 8. 51.5% of faculties agreed that the college provides adequate opportunities and support to them for upgrading their skills and qualifications.
- 9. Most of the faculties (51.5%) were of opinion that the College authority recognized and appreciated the faculties and staff for their good work.
- 10. 57.6% of faculties agreed that the common rooms, classrooms, toilets, labs, playground of the college are clean and well maintained.

#### **Actions Taken:**

- 1. The vision, mission & objectives of DHSK Commerce College are displayed in the college campus, College Website and soft copies of the same have been circulated among the new incumbents.
- 2. Faculty members are given full freedom to express their views regarding choice of subjects to be taught, books to be purchased in the library; IT related services so that they put in their best efforts.
- 3. Faculty members are encouraged to develop their knowledge base through participation in conferences and seminars. Besides, faculty development programs are also organized from time to time
- 4. Faculties are allowed to apply directly for participation in seminars and conferences through the Principal. They are also paid registration fees for presentation of papers.
- 5. The HODs have been instructed to involve faculty members in subject allocations and the HODs maintain proper record of suggestions given by faculty members for improving teaching and learning
- 6. The faculties are given freedom and flexibility in adopting new pedagogic techniques for effective curriculum delivery. Faculty are instructed to help other faculty members in using Smart boards effectively
- 7. All department have been asked to submit detailed report regarding the infrastructure facilities available to the faculty members in the department
- 8. The Research Committee is given the responsibility for the publication of peer reviewed research journal with ISSN where faculties are motivated to publish papers.
- 9. The principal and HODs is given responsibility to motivate and counsel the faculty members to work in cooperation for effective outcomes
- 10. Regular monitoring is done regarding cleanliness and other facilities in the common room, classrooms and washrooms
- 11. Any suggestions from faculty members will be invited to get better the quality of services of canteen in the college and accordingly actions will be taken
