





STUDENTS SATISFACTION SURVEY & ACTION TAKEN REPORT: 2020-21


Objectives of the Survey:


- a) To know the opinion of students towards academic environment of the college.
- b) To understand the need and requirements of students towards facilities available in the college campus.









































































































1. MAIN OBSERVATIONS / FINDINGS FROM THE SURVEY:

- 2. Majority of students i.e., 51.3% of the students have responded that the syllabus for B.Com courses were covered 85 to 100%.
- 3. 63% students opined that, the teacher's preparation to class was satisfactory. It was recommended to the teachers should continue in preparing to classes on regular basis.
- 4. Around 65.6% students have said that, the teachers' presentation and communication skills was effective during classroom interactions.
- 5. Of the total response of 154 responses from students, 43.5% of students have responded that, the teachers' approach to teaching is very good.
- 6. More than 55% students feel that the teachers' internal assessment process was always fair. Around 8% of them feel there is a scope of improvements in the process of internal assessment evaluation. Therefore, it is recommended to the teachers to improve the process of internal assessment of the student.
- 7. 40.3% of students feel that the teacher every time discussed with them about the performance of their assignment.
- 8. 28.6% of students have said that the College takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit, excursion opportunities for students. But 10.4% of students feel improvement in this case.
- 9. Guidance and monitoring play a vital role in the development of students learning process. It was found that over 45.5% students were responded that the teaching and mentoring process in cognitive, social and emotional growth are very significant.
- 10. 42.2% of students agreed that the College provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow during their stay in the college.
- 11. It was found that 39.6% of students responded that the teacher informs every time to each and every students about their expected competencies, course outcome and programme outcomes.
- 12. Majority of students (42.2%) said that the teacher did a necessary follow-up with an assigned task given to them.
- 13. More than 50% students responded that the teachers often illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.
- 14. From the survey it has been noticed that only 34.4% of students feel that the teachers identify their strength and encourage them with providing right level of challenges very reasonably.
- 15. 37.7% of students said that the teachers are able identify their weakness usually and help them to overcome the weakness.

- 16. Majority of the students (39%) were remained neutral in the case of engagement of students in monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.
- 17. It is seen that, 42.2 of students feel that the College / teachers use the student centric methods moderately.
- 18. Majority of the students (40.3%) agreed that the College moderately provide soft skills and employability skill to the students for the world of work.
- 19. More than half of the students have agreed that teachers encourage them to participate in the extra-curriculum activities.
- 20. Over 38% of students have said that 70% to 89% of teachers' knowledge on usage of ICT was good. But 10.4% student feels that improvements are required in enhancing knowledge on usage of ICT tools.
- 21. It was observed that 51.3% of students feel that the College's administrative offices are helpful and 33.8% of students opinioned that it is very helpful in case of administrative approaches.
- 22. It was observed that, 50% of the students have said availability of the sufficient course books, text books, journals, magazines etc. are adequate.
- 23. It was observed that, over 31.8% students feel the library facility of the College is very good.
- 24. 28.6% of the students said that the Computer & Internet facility of the College is very good.
- 25. It was noticed that majority of the students (30.5%) said that the free admission system & scholarships facility of the College is good.
- 26. 29.2% of students said that the Boy's / Girls' Common room facility of the College is excellent.
- 27. It is observed that 38.3% of the student feel that the NCC & NSS activities of the College is excellent.
- 28. Majority of the students (30.5%) have said that the Canteen and drinking water facility of the College is very good.
- 29. More than 50% of students are satisfied with the overall cleanliness in campus and is excellent in nature.



Action Taken Report on the basis findings of survey:

THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS HAVE BEEN TAKEN BY THE COLLEGE AUTHORITY ON THE BASIS OF FEEDBACK RECEIVED FROM STUDENTS

- a) Purchase of additional books for library and departments as per students requirement
- b) College in association with IQAC, NSS and other Cells organized online Workshops, Seminars, Quiz competition and talk programmes to stimulate students knowledge
- c) The student's are directed to take part in feedback process fearlessly to find out the shortcomings of department and the individual teacher if any with classical teaching modules.
- d) Organized number of environment friendly initiatives with the help of NSS, NCC, Women Cell etc. and ensuring participation of maximum students in such initiatives
- e) Most of the teachers have already included modern teaching aids in teaching. They have started preparing power point presentation and other innovative teaching aids to stimulate the students for better understanding.
- f) New multipurpose multi-storied building has been constructed at the college campus.
- g) Existing classrooms have been renovated by fitting tiles and new window panels.
- h) Renovations have been made to the College Library.
- i) New Gym has been constructed in the ground floor.
- j) Improvement has been made of College's Banipur Land by constructing new boundary wall and earth filling.
- k) The Girls hostel has been renovated to accommodate more number of students.
- l) A number of environment friendly initiatives by NSS, NCC, Women Cell etc. Has been conducted.

- 4. The college also intended to know their progression to higher education and the present professional status.



Report on Alumni's feedback:

- 1. 57.1% alumni felt that the academic environment of the college was excellent while 28.6% opine that it was good.
- 2. 64.3 % alumni found the infrastructure of the college excellent while 28.6 % agreed that it was good.
- 3. According to the half of the alumni the knowledge and skill of the faculties were excellent while approximately other 43 percent said that it was good.
- 4. 21.4 % alumni remarked the library as excellent while majority (64.3 %) said it was good.
- 5. In respect of quality support material provision half of the alumni said that it was good. Almost one fourth said that it was excellent. Similar statistics we have found in respect of social environment in terms of diversity and inclusiveness.
- 6. Almost 36 percent alumni said that extracurricular activities and fest organised by the college was good.
- 7. Majority of the respondent (approx 29%) opined that the placement and other opportunities provided by the college were good.
- 8. The highest academic qualification of the alumni is Ph.D.
- 9. 21.4 % alumni are at present self employed whereas 14.3 % are working in public sector.7.1 percent are working in private sector.

Analysis and outcomes:

- 1. Alumni are highly satisfied with the academic environment as well as infrastructure of the college.
- 2. Alumni are also satisfied with the knowledge and skill of the teacher.
- 3. They find the college library helpful.
- 4. Regarding the placement and other extracurricular activities there is a mix reaction.
- 5. Most of the alumni are having either their own business or they are working in public sector.


- a) To know the opinion of teachers of DHSK Commerce College towards academic environment of the college.
- b) To understand the need and requirements of teachers towards facilities available in the college campus in the process of teaching learning.




























OBSERVATIONS FROM THE SURVEY:

- 1. 72.7 % of teachers responded opined that the present course syllabus of B.Com under Dibrugarh University is need based.
- 2. 86.4 % of total teachers responded agree that the current course curriculum has substantial content for students to learn.
- 3. 72.7 % of total respondent teachers' view that the syllabus outcome of undergraduate programme is well defined.
- 4. 68.2 % of respondent teachers' states that the ongoing course curriculum is having a good academic flexibility.
- 5. With respect to fulfil the needs of the students 77.2% of teachers' respondent assume that the present course content is sufficient in doing so.
- 6. 82.8 % teacher respondents believe that sufficient numbers of text books and reference books are available for students in the college library.
- 7. In terms of quality of ICT (Information and Communication Technology) facilities available in the college, 72.75% are satisfied and believe it as adequate. Though 13.6 % respondent teachers disagree with the statement.
- 8. 90.9% respondent teacher agrees that the environment in the college is conducive for Teaching, Learning, Research and extension activities.
- 9. 95.5% respondent feels that the college administration is maintaining friendly relations with Teachers.
- 10. 95.4 % teacher respondents' states that the college is supportive in providing adequate opportunities and support to faculties in upgrading their academic skills.

Objectives of Parent's feedback on institute:


- 1. To provide parents the opportunities to comment on the academic infrastructure and learning experiences of their ward.

- 3. To create a baseline for faculties and library services to improve their quality academic environment of the college.








































Report on Parents Feedback:

- 1. 63.8% of the parents have found the academic infrastructure of the college as good.
- 2. 66.2% of the parents have found the learning experiences of their wards in the Collegeas good.
- 3. 49.3% of parents judge the College library as good.
- 4. 60.9% of parentsfound that the academic skills and knowledge of the College faculties were good.
- 5. Half of the parents (52.7%) said that the resources provided by the College were good. 58.5% of them found the College to be a good place for their children to have social environment in terms of diversity and inclusiveness of the College.
- 6. 44.4% of the parents found that the NCC, NSS and sports facilities of the College were good.
