


# STUDENT SATISFACTORY SURVEY 2018

### DEPARTMENT WISE ANALYSIS HAS BEEN SHOWN AS FOLLOWS:


#### 1. Assamese:

The Sixth Semester students of the Department of Assamese expressed their satisfaction with the aspects covered by the questions 1 to 12 (Refer Annexure I) as far as their department was concerned which is undoubtedly a welcome sign. However, for questions 13 and 14, their responses corresponded to 'less than satisfactory' category as mentioned in the methodology above.



#### 2. Economics:


Except for question 14 which addressed the issue of the use of ICT for teaching purposes, for which the feedback of the respondents corresponded to 'less than satisfactory', the students expressed their satisfaction for all the other aspects covered by the rest of the questions.






## 5. Anthropology:

The feedback from the students of the Department of Anthropology showed that they were satisfied with aspects dealt with by the questions 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 12 as mentioned in the questionnaire (Refer Annexure D). So, the teachers of the department should try to maintain the status by giving continued efforts. The feedback was 'below satisfactory' for questions 6, 7, 9, 10, 11 and 13 which indicates that efforts should be taken by teachers to improvise on these factors. The feedback for question 14 which was related to the use of ICT in classroom teaching was 'poor' which calls for special focus and attention from the authority. However, for this, infrastructural support is necessary too.




## 6. Botany:

From the Students' Sixth Satisfaction Survey conducted among the Sixth Semester students of the Department of Botany, it was found that the students were satisfied with all the aspects covered in the questionnaire as far as their department was concerned.




## 7. Chemistry:

The Sixth Semester students of the Department of Chemistry expressed satisfaction on all the aspects covered in the questionnaire except regarding the usage of ICT in classroom teaching, where the feedback was less than satisfactory.




## 8. Physics:

The feedback obtained from the students of the Department of Physics was exactly the same as the feedback provided by those from the Department of Chemistry, which implies that the students desire the teachers to use ICT to impart education in the classroom.



## 9. Zoology:

The Sixth Semester students of the department expressed 'less than satisfactory' responses for all the aspects covered in the questionnaire as far their department was concerned. This calls for action to be taken by the Head of the Department and the teachers of the department to see that the situation improves the next time. The only aspect where the students expressed their satisfaction was related to 'How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?' However, on the brighter side, it can be seen that none of the aspects covered in the questionnaire was termed as 'poor' by the students.



### Overall Departmental Analysis:

From the analysis done on each of the 14 questions contained in the Students' Satisfaction Survey, the responses of the students were positive and encouraging for almost all the aspects. However, one common factor that needs to be looked into and addressed by the authority as well as by the departments concerned is related to the use of ICT in the classroom for teaching purposes. The feedback from the students indicate that they prefer teaching aids other than the traditional 'chalk and talk' method to impart education in the classroom and desire the usage of ICT for such purposes. This calls for having atleast one digital classroom in each department and faculty may use audio-visual aids in classroom teaching.
