

Action Taken Report 2019-20

1. One Week faculty Development Programme:

A one-week faculty development programme on “Behavioural Remodelling and the Use of ICT in Classroom Teaching” from 14 – 18 October 2019. The programme was jointly organised by E&ICT Academy, IIT Guwahati.

2. Successful Running of Job-oriented Course:

Job-oriented course on Tally ERP 0.9 has been successfully going on.

3. Dibru College Annual Lecture 2019:

An eagerly awaited event of the Dibrugarhians ‘The Dibru College Annual Lecture 2019’ was held on 4th November 2019. It was graced by eminent historian and former Chairman of the Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) Prof. David Reid Syiemlieh as the Invited Speaker. Prof. Syiemlieh delivered a resourceful lecture on ‘North East India: Mutiny, Freedom Struggle and Integration’

Prof Syiemlieh said that the North-East has been neglected in the Indian history because historians of mainland India do not consider the region ‘significant’. According to him, the modern histories of India make little mention of the region other than its annexation into the British colonial state, with some mention in economic histories of the discovery of tea and its cultivation and the production of Assam oil. The impression created reading the textbooks on the history of the Indian National Movement is that the region did not have anything to do with the Indian Freedom Movement, the eminent historian pointed out.

He further emphasised on incorporating the history of the North East into the broader Indian history and encouraged young researchers and the historians of the region to take up presentation of history of the North East into Indian History.

The lecture was attended by various invited citizens of Dibrugarh, several eminent historians of the region, faculty members of the Department of History, Dibrugarh University, nearby colleges and the host college, the Press besides the students of the Department of History, Dibrugarh University, those from Dibru College as well as those of nearby educational institutions.

4. Publication of Newsletter By IQAC:

The newsletter lilted Udayan is publishing by-annually. There are few new additions added with the newsletter. The activities of the teachers, students and the departments are arranged chronologically. Further, if the titles of articles, poems, etc. are in a vernacular language, the original title should be retained without any translation into English.
